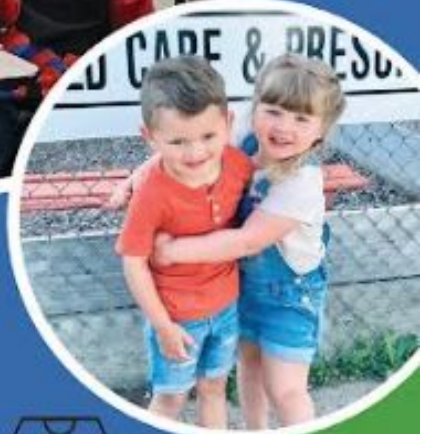

St. Martin School will be holding a Santa's Workshop on Friday, **December 9th**. Santa's Workshop is an opportunity for our students to "go shopping" for Christmas presents here at school. Here is how it will work.

We have invited local businesses and crafters to set up tables of items that will be marked at \$5.00 or less for our children to buy as Christmas presents. The children can purchase gifts for individuals of all ages. The children will come into the gym by grade to shop for gifts. We will have people available to help the children select and wrap their purchases.

This is not a fundraiser for the school. It is an opportunity for the children to feel good about themselves by being able to buy gifts for their families.

We are asking that if you want your child to participate that you follow these instructions.

1. Take a plain white envelope and put your child's name on the front.
2. Under his/her name put the name of the people that they will be shopping for and the amount of money that is to be spent on each. (For example – Mom \$5.00, Grandma \$3.00, etc.)
3. Put the amount of money equal to the total to be spent in the envelope. **(PLEASE SEND CASH, not a check)** and seal it.
4. Have Christmas labels filled out to put on the wrapped gift. Thank You.
5. If you do not want your child to participate, please contact your child's teacher by Wednesday, December 7th.
