Runner serves the School of Education, particularly within their trauma-informed care program. Each school year, ten new students are trained as handlers and go on to develop and implement their own outreach programs, typically in schools or nursing homes. Finally, we are excited to welcome **Trixie**, the newest member of Concordia's Comfort Dog team. Trixie serves in the Veteran Services office and was trained at a facility in Iowa.
